

Job Description: Cable Machine Operator

We are seeking a highly motivated, Cable machine operator that will oversee the work flow in the manufacture of products. MegaPhase products include coaxial cable, cable assemblies, and connectors.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Daily Operation of Cable machinery including material loading and set-up of equipment.
- Insure Cable product meets mechanical and electrical requirements.
- Ability to read blueprints and engineering dwgs.
- Prepare new tooling, maintain tooling and spares inventory. Diagnose and repair die and equipment problems.
- Obtains correct material according to work order specifications.
- Directs movement and work flow to appropriate work centers.
- Measure materials and cut Cable armor to indicated lengths.
- Maintain Cable machines including machine lubrication
- Verifies and records inventory counts and recommends reorders to ensure available supply.
- Suggests manufacturing process improvements.
- Maintains work areas in a clean, orderly and safe manner to include returning tools to designated areas.
- Adheres to established policies and procedures paying special attention to safety regulations.
- Notifies management of product discrepancies, equipment malfunctions and/or personal injuries.
- Wears personal protective equipment in accordance with training guidelines.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Education/Experience

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); and strong mechanical background with an understanding of metal forming, machinist certificate a plus.

Language Ability

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write simple reports and correspondence. Ability to communicate with supervisors and other production personnel.

Work Environment
